

## CALL FOR NOMINATIONS

### The Bronisław Malinowski Award in the Social Sciences

Polish Institute of Arts and Sciences in America

Deadline: March 1, 2017

Named for an eminent social scientist and founding member of the Polish Institute of Arts and Sciences in America, the Bronisław Malinowski Award recognizes a scholar in one of the fields of the social sciences who has written a book of particular value and significance dealing with an aspect of the Polish experience. The book should represent an exemplary piece of scholarly research published in any of the fields encompassed by the social sciences including anthropology, economics, political science, and sociology.

#### Criteria:

- The book must be written in the English language.
- The author must be a scholar living and working in North America.
- The book must have been published during the five calendar years preceding conferral of the award.
- Books containing original research or new, original syntheses are eligible for consideration; edited collections are not eligible for consideration.

#### Nominators should provide:

- A letter of justification for why this candidate is deserving of the award;
- A curriculum vitae of the nominee that includes a bibliography of significant publications and a list of accomplishments;
- Up to three additional letters of support may be provided.
